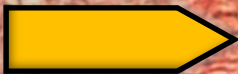

A visit from Indiana Secretary of State Diego Morales



On Saturday June 24th, StoneBridge Trucking had a monumental day. With the help of the Batesville and Greensburg Decatur County Chambers of Commerce, The 812, WRBI, WTRE, State Representative Randy Frye, and Jacob Nobbe productions, the StoneBridge Open House was a day to be remembered. 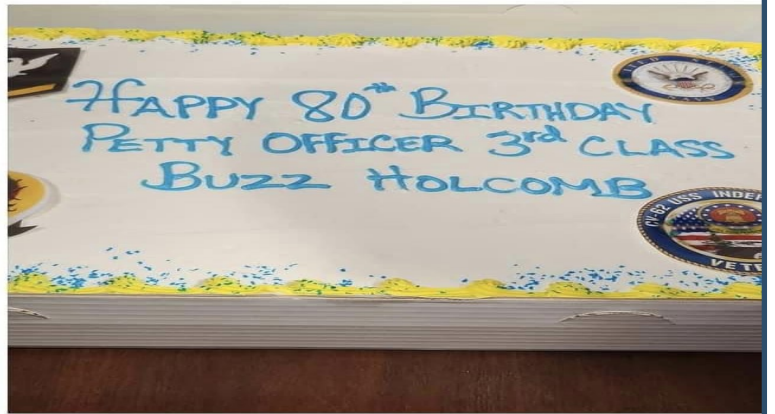

StoneBridge Expediting and Small Load Trucking at the junction of SR 46 and S Co Rd 600 E is a growing company that considers itself a “family,” and proves it by taking care of its people, and giving back to its community.

With a fleet of fourteen box trucks ranging in size from 16 to 24 feet and skid transit vans in 3, 2, and 1 skid sizes, StoneBridge delivers small to large loads to all 48 states and, according to CEO Shane Kennedy, StoneBridge “can have someone on the job in an hour.”

Experienced, licensed drivers are allowed to choose their loads, driving hours and time off and StoneBridge is hiring.



A History of Growth

President and founder Butch Kennedy worked in Greenburg at Delta Faucet Company but wanted something more. He purchased an ailing antique store on I46 where StoneBridge is currently, and ran it, adding expediting services later.

In 2013, having grown the fleet to 4 box trucks, Butch needed knee replacement and wanted to retire, so he handed the responsibility to local businessman Garry Hadler, who grew the company until his retirement in 2017. At that time, Brad Stephens was added to the team as Fleet Operator.

By 2019, the company had tripled their fleet and their client list and began searching for a larger location. That same year, Kennedy's son Shane retired to the reserves and took the helm at StoneBridge

Fleet Maintenance Manager JD McClintic and Dispatch Brock Bayless. Company staff is now 23 total personnel, and according to Shane, "Everyone is a driver at StoneBridge." As friends for many years, Shane and Ops Manager Stephens confess they often "agree to disagree," but some values are never argued, because both believe in "family, faith and service to country" as key to growing the business.

Service to Country

Stephens and Kennedy have both served their country- Stephens retired from the Army after 14 years, and Kennedy is in Air Force reservist as part of a 24 year career. He was recently promoted to the rank of Major.



Owner Butch Kennedy served in active duty in Vietnam and so duty to country is inbred to all three men. Both Shane and Brad take pride in honoring those who have served and are serving, and many are drivers for the company. Those men are honored in the annual “Year in Review,” where their names and their stories are featured. One such feature is about StoneBridge operator and US Navy Veteran Boyd “Buzz” Holcomb, whose own father was a veteran. Buzz enlisted in the Navy in 1960, because he knew getting drafted during Viet Nam was inevitable.

The Navy seemed a good fit, and Buzz went to NATTO Jacksonville to study Aviation Administration before serving in the Gulf of Mexico during the Cuban Missile Crisis. US Navy Veteran Bill Pike is another Operator Veteran working at StoneBridge.

Driving a bus for the Shelby school system full time, he spends his summer, Christmas and spring breaks driving for StoneBridge. Pike joined the Navy in 1988 to become and Aircrew Survival Technician/Parachute rigger.

Graduating top in his class, he joined the e-@ Hawkeye Surveillance Squadron in Miramar, California, where he 3 ½ years attached to the USS Carl Vinson and later, the USS Kitty Hawk.

Service to Country

Bob King is another veteran driver for StoneBridge.

King enlisted as a Boatswain Mate and attended boot camp at Naval Station Great Lakes before being stationed at Norfolk Virginia with the Nuclear Weapons Training center. In 1965 he took a deployment on the USS Nimble.

Faith

Stephens refers to a biblical passage about community service when he talks about his faith and its importance at StoneBridge.

When stormy weather and destructive tornadoes hit Western Kentucky hard in March of this year, Stephens knew that StoneBridge needed to do something to help.

Taking donations from locals, drivers from StoneBridge took 5 trucks and a van full of relief items. They did the same for the Eastern Kentucky Floods.

StoneBridge shipped supplies from Gecom and Steel Technologies for the victims of the Gatlinburg Wildfires.

StoneBridge has partnered with Bohman Tree Farm since 2003 by donating delivery of Christmas trees to troops stationed around the world.

"It's all about giving back to the reason we're here," he said.

"We have so much work to do at StoneBridge, but when people hear our name, I don't want a dollar sign attached to it. I want them know that we have the resources to help people achieve their goals, and that we offer them a reasonable way to do it." Said Shane.

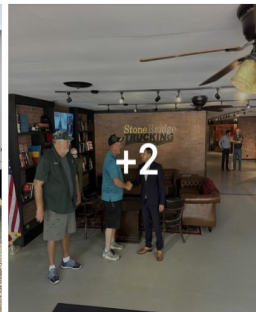
